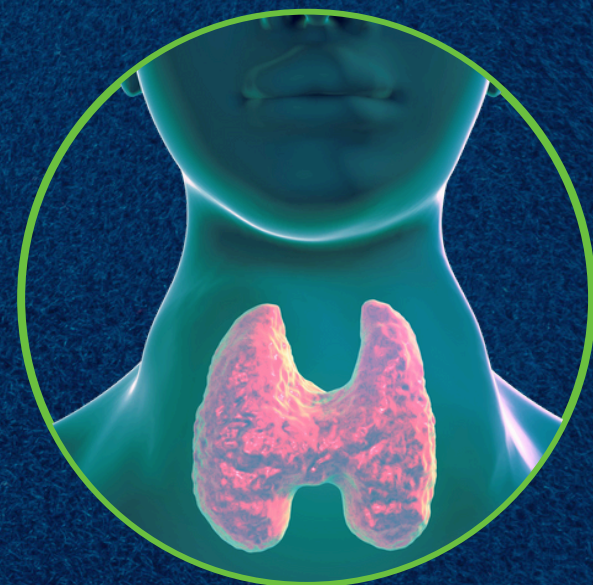


# Help us find a new approach to treat Graves' Disease

## CONSIDER TAKING PART IN THIS CLINICAL STUDY WHICH IS TESTING AN INVESTIGATIONAL MEDICATION FOR PEOPLE LIVING WITH GRAVES' DISEASE

Graves' Disease is an autoimmune condition where the body's antibodies attack the thyroid. This causes many symptoms like heat intolerance, tremor, weight loss, diarrhea and dyspnea (difficulty in breathing) and in severe cases when left untreated can cause heart and liver failure.

This study aims to understand whether the investigational medication can help treat Graves' Disease with improved side effects compared to current therapies. It is hoped the investigational medication can treat the autoimmune disease instead of just treating the symptoms of Graves's Disease.

The medication is designed to be injected under the skin by the clinic staff.

If you or someone you know is living with Graves' Disease, this could be an opportunity to contribute to vital research that may help change the future of treatment

- **Are aged between 18- 65 years**
- **Have been diagnosed with Graves' Disease**
- **Are able and willing to take part in the study for up to 30 weeks**
